Subject: DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) Spray Gun Approval

Dear Mr. Charpie:

Thank you for sending SWCAA the information on your new DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun. In your letter dated March 15, 2004 you requested written approval to sell and operate this spray gun in SWCAA's jurisdiction.

Reviewing the test data for the spray gun, you have shown that under proper operation the DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun can maintain transfer efficiencies comparable with HVLP spray guns. SWCAA will allow the use of the DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) at individual facilities through receipt of an Air Discharge Permit (ADP) application and issuance of an ADP with specific requirements applicable to the spray gun.

However, SWCAA cannot provide equipment certifications and does not maintain a certified equipment list. All applicants must submit an ADP application and receive an ADP prior to use of the spray gun. Issuing an ADP provides the opportunity to establish parameters to assure proper operation of the spray gun.
