Rule 427 Transfer Efficiency Approval of ITW Devilbiss GFG-670 (Plus)

Spray Gun- re: Your letter dated October 15, 2002- end user notification

Dear Mr. Charpie;

Pursuant to comments in your letter of October 15, 2002 regarding end user notification for the DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun, please review revised conditions #4 and #5 below. The revised conditions below supersede the conditions found in our previous letter dated August 29, 2002. The DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun is approved for operation subject to Rule 427, Automotive Refinishing Operations, Section C2.a.3. This approval is subject to the following conditions.

- ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun fo use within the jurisdiction of the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District that the gun is only approved for the application of coatings subject to Rule 427.
- This approval is only valid if the air pressure to the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun is equal to or less than 40 PSIG. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW Devilbiss GFG-670 spray gun that the maximum air pressure supplied to the spray gun shall not exceed 40 PSIG.
- 3. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply a spray gun mounted needle valve and a pressure gauge clearly identifying the maximum allowable spray gun inlet air pressure to each individual purchasing an ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun for use within the jurisdiction of the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun that the spray gun mounted needle valve and pressure gauge shall be attached to the spray gun and be in good

working condition whenever the spray gun is in operation.

4. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written instructions with the DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun which refer the end user to a website containing a notification form to be sent to the Imperial County Air Pollution Control District. The notification shall be either e-mailed to chrismarcus@imperialcounty.net, or mailed to:

- 5. Notification shall be made within thirty (30) days of the sale of the referenced spray gun.
- 6. This approval is only valid for the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun model tested.
