Re: ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) Spray Gun Approval for Rule 4602

Dear Mr. Charpie:

The San Joaquin Valley Air Pollution Control District (District) has evaluated your recent request to again consider the sale of the DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun within the jurisdiction of the District. We reviewed the test results you submitted to the South Coast Air Quality Management District and their approval of these spray guns. Based on the overall review, we have determined that the DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray guns are approved for use under District Rule 4602, Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Coating Operations. The test results indicate that the spray gun is capable of achieving equivalent or better transfer efficiency than high-volume, low-pressure coating application equipment. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

- ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification with each ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun sold or distributed for use within the jurisdiction of the District that the spray gun is only approved for the application of coatings subject to District Rule 4602.
- 2. This approval is only valid if the air pressure supplied to the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun is equal to or less than 40 psig. ITW Refinishing shall supply written notification with each ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun sold or distributed for use within the jurisdiction of the District that the maximum air pressure supplied to the spray gun shall not exceed 40 psig.
- 3. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply a spray gun mounted needle valve and a pressure gauge clearly identifying the maximum allowable spray gun inlet air pressure with each ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun sold or distributed for use within the jurisdiction of the District. ITW Automotive

Refinishing shall supply written notification with each ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun sold or distributed for use within the jurisdiction of the District that the spray gun mounted needle valve and pressure gauge shall be attached to the spray gun and be in good working condition whenever the spray gun is in operation.

 This approval is only valid for the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun model tested.
