Approval of ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) Spray Gun

Dear Mr. Charpie:

Per your request, this letter serves as approval for use of the GFG-670 spray gun in Santa Barbara County. This equipment may be used in accordance with APCD Rule 339.D.7.f, based on South Coast Air Quality Management District's (SCAQMD) August 9, 2002 approval letter to ITW Automotive Refinishing.

Consistent with SCAQMD's conditional approval, the APCD's approval is based on the following conditions:

- This approval is only valid is only valid if the air pressure supplied to the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun is equal to or less than 40 psig. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun that the maximum air pressure supplied to the spray gun shall not exceed 40 psig.
- 2. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply a spray gun mounted needle valve and a pressure gauge clearly identifying the maximum allowable spray gun inlet air pressure to each individual purchasing an ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun for use within the jurisdiction of the Santa Barbara County Air Pollution Control District. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun that the spray gun mounted needle valve and pressure gauge shall be attached to the spray gun and be in good working condition whenever the spray gun is in operation.
- 3. This approval is only valid for the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 spray gun model tested.
