Subject: ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) Spray Gun

Dear Mr. Charpie:

The Ventura County Air Pollution Control District (VCAPCD) staff has reviewed the documents that you submitted on August 14, 2002 and the facsimile that you submitted on September 5, 2002. We conclude that you have demonstrated that the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun has transfer efficiency equivalent to a high-volume, lowpressure spray gun and that the spray gun is capable of achieving at least 65 percent transfer efficiency.

Therefore, pursuant to VCAPCD Rule 74.18.B.4.e, the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun is approved for use in operations subject to Rule 74.18, "Motor Vehicle and Mobile Equipment Coating Operations". The approval is subject to the following conditions.

- 1. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun for use within Ventura County that the gun is only approved for the application of coatings subject to VCAPCD Rule 74.18.
- 2. This approval is only valid if the air pressure supplied to the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun is equal to or less than 40 psig. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the spray gun that the maximum air pressure supplied to the spray gun shall not exceed 40 psig.
- 3. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply a spray gun mounted needle valve and a pressure gauge clearly identifying the maximum allowable spray gun inlet air pressure to each individual purchasing an ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun for use within Ventura County. ITW Automotive Refinishing shall supply written notification to each individual purchasing the spray gun that the spray gun mounted needle valve and pressure gauge shall be attached to the spray gun and be in good working condition whenever the spray gun is in operation.

4. This approval in only valid for the ITW DeVilbiss GFG-670 (Plus) spray gun model tested.
